- Social Workers are skilled health care professionals who hold a Bachelors or Masters Degree in Social Work and are required to be registered to practice in Saskatchewan
- Social Workers employed in health care assist with clients in rural and urban hospitals, schools, outpatient clinics, treatment centers, community outreach work and home care
- Saskatchewan families and communities struggling to cope with the effects of mental and physical illness, benefit when Social Workers are there to help
- HSAS Social Workers help to provide parenting and life skill programs, addiction and mental health services, medical social work, long term and palliative care, domestic violence and acquired brain injury programs
- HSAS Social Workers are required to carry heavy case loads in their efforts to provide compassionate care to Saskatchewan residents of all age groups and of every walk of life
